

## PLANNING STAGE

- Visit nobleremc.com and review our Electric Standards Manual, under the Member Services tab.
- Acquire site plan/drawings and/or plot plan from survey, detailing property lines, driveway, and septic field. Include dimensions of the house to the right-of-way.
- Acquire a building permit from your respective county. (Kosciusko County does not require a building permit.)
- Pin/stake the house location. Complete soil samples for septic field.

## SITE MEETING

- Call Noble REMC to request an appointment for an onsite meeting. *This call can be made by a homeowner, electrician, or builder.*
- Bring site plans and details on home heating/cooling, water heater, and other home appliances.
- Discuss topics, including: path of service, right-of-way clearing, type of service (meter base size), location of meter base, underground or overhead service, location of transformer (if applicable).
- Receive cost estimate from Noble REMC after the meeting.
- Set up an account with Noble REMC.

## TEMPORARY SERVICE (IF APPLICABLE)

- Electrician or homeowner required to pull electric permit for county inspection.
- Install temporary electric service. *This can be done by homeowner or electrician.*
- Call building department to complete inspection.
- Call Noble REMC after inspection is approved.

## PERMANENT SERVICE

- Install permanent electric service. *This can be done by homeowner or electrician.*
- Call building department to complete inspection.
- Call Noble REMC after inspection is approved.

## FINAL INSPECTION

- Noble REMC will perform site visit and verify conditions are ready for installation.
- Noble REMC will flag proposed wiring location to electrical equipment.
- Sign Noble REMC trenching agreement.
- Noble REMC will install permanent service.
