Your questions about EVs, answered.

How far can I drive on a full charge?

Every manufacturer has different battery capacities. Electric vehicle ranges start around 110 miles and reach over 370 miles.

How do I find charging stations if I want to take a road trip?

There are several nationwide charging networks available, all of which have an app you can download on your phone to help find charging stations and plan your route. The public charging network is growing, and chargers are being installed in more diverse places, as demand increases.

How often should I charge my EV?

Once your vehicle is programmed, it's a good habit to plug it in when you get home, and it will charge nightly.

What is the dependability of an electric vehicle's motor and battery, as well as general maintenance?

To date, there have been few reported instances of battery or motor issues, and according to a survey by Consumer Reports, the maintenance cost of an EV is half the cost of a traditional gasoline-powered vehicle.

What is the impact to my electric bill?

As an example, the all-wheel drive Ford Mustang Mach-E (3.07 miles per kWh), driving 200 miles per week, with Noble REMC's current rates: $200 \div 3.07 = 65.15$ kWh or \$6.50 weekly for a total of \$26 on your monthly bill. (This is an estimate, as driving habits will affect the actual number.)
